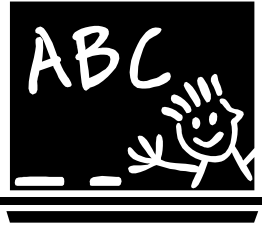

Entry deadline (entry and fees):

Must be submitted on-line by June 1, 2011 at 11:59pm (Pacific Time) at <http://www.lhvcfair.com/>. Please note there will be no on-line technical support past 7:00pm on entry closing date.

Delivery of Exhibits:

Wednesday, June 8th and Thursday, June 9th from 2:00pm to 8:00 pm at Sonora High School Ag Mechanics Shop, Room 623. Use the front entrance and follow the directional signs.

Awards Ceremony

Sunday, June 12th 4:00pm at Sonora High School, Fair Livestock Tent

How do I enter?

To use our fast, easy & secure on-line entry registration by visit www.lhvcfair.com starting May 1st.

1. Click on on-line entries.
2. Click on Exhibitor Registration in the tool bar on the left side of the screen.
3. Enter Teachers Name (first and last). Check the "I am a new exhibitor." Click on Continue.
4. Exhibitor Registration: Fill in required fields (password, address, etc.). Use Teachers last name and grade level for group name (example Ms. Smith's 5th Grade Class). Click on continue.
5. Exhibitor Information Review: Review your information and click on continue.
6. Entries: Choose "Youth Building" DEPARTMENT. An additional drop down menu will appear. Select the "School Class Group Entry" DIVISION. Select the class your project falls into. See List of Eligible Projects for Schools for descriptions. You will need to write a DESCRIPTION of the item you wish to exhibit. Select your school's name in the CLUB drop down menu. Click continue. If this is the only entry, click on continue again.
7. Review Your Cart: click on Check Out.
8. Payment: Choose a credit card and fill in the required information.
9. Confirmation: Print you confirmation page for your records.
10. Make sure you log off. If you need to make changes later, you may use you name and password to log back in to your account.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Who can enter?

Students of La Habra Schools and its neighboring school districts including Fullerton, Whittier, La Habra Heights and Buena Park. Students grades Kindergarten through 8th grade only are eligible in the Classroom Best Contest. Students Kindergarten through 12th graders are welcome to enter individual projects under the youth building division.

How do I enter?

On-line registration: Entries must be submitted at <http://www.lhvcfair.com> by 11:59pm (Pacific Time) on or before June 1, 2011. Online entries will receive an email confirmation. Technical support will not be available after 7:00pm.

Late entries will not be accepted. No faxes.

Is there a fee?

The processing fee is \$10.00 per class. **Processing fees are non-refundable.**

Limit of Entries?

Each classroom may enter one project. Please supply a list of the students involved in a group project at the time of delivery.

How do I label my students work?

Instructors should label each child's work with their name. All work should be mounted onto butcher paper not to exceed 6 feet by 10 feet and labeled with the teacher's name, grade level, and school name prior to delivery.

When do I bring my entries?

All registered entries will be received at Sonora High School Ag Mechanics Shop. **See Calendar for delivery dates.** Fair passes for students and teachers will be distributed at this time.

When do I pick up my entries?

All entries must be picked up on dates and times specified in the calendar. Items may be picked up by another person if they present the claim checks and a signed written authorization from the teacher. The Fair will not deliver or mail entries to exhibitors. Exhibits not picked up at this time become the property of the Fair and will be disposed of promptly.

What else do I need to know?

No entry will be accepted should the exhibitor describe conditions under which he/she will exhibit. All display decisions are the responsibility of the Coordinator. The La Habra Valley Community Fair will not be responsible for any loss or damage of any kind. Work must be in good taste and suitable for family viewing as determined by the Fair management.

DISPLAY REQUIREMENTS:

All class work should not exceed 6' x 10' including the matting. Murals should not exceed 6' in length by 10' in width. Writings of poetry or stories may be illustrated.

RECOGNITION:

All items will be awarded a ribbon based on the Modified Danish System of judging. Additional merit awards may also be given.

CREDENTIAL POLICY: Each student participating will receive one child courtesy pass to the Fair. For school/group projects, a list of all participating exhibitors must be submitted with the entry form. The teacher/leader of each group exhibit will receive one adult courtesy pass.

LIST OF ELIGIBLE PROJECTS FOR SCHOOLS CLASS PROJECTS

All work is divided into two classes:

Class 1: Single class projects not to exceed 6' x 10'

Class 2: Class individual students learning projects mounted on butcher paper not to exceed 6' by 10' in length.

Acceptable projects are:

Art: drawings, paintings, Meet the Masters, etc. mounted as a group

Community Service: Explain the project/include photos, mount on poster board.

Educational Projects: Mount info on poster board.

Environmental Project: Mount info on poster board.

Photography: Prints should be at least 5" x 7" and matted as a group.

Quilting: Make a fabric or paper quilt as a group project.

School Gardens: Display photos and info about the garden on poster board.

Writing: Write a poem or story related to food (nutrition, agriculture, eating, cooking, etc.) displayed on a single mounted poster or butcher paper.

History Projects: Missions, Pyramid, Mask, Models, etc/
